#### HOUSE-KEEPING DETAILS

1. Arriving by car: There is on-street parking along Granville street and along West 8th Avenue. There is also a rear parking lot/drop off area behind the building. DO NOT park in the neighbouring spots (spot numbers 10/9/8/7). Only use the guest spaces, or space #6 (PMM's assigned spot). We have learned quickly that tickets come fast and the threat of towing is real! So we want to avoid any heartaches with our students/parents.
2. Arriving by bus: The 99 B-Line bus and 9 bus both have stops at Broadway outside the Clock tower building.
3. Door Code: to enter through the rear door, punch in the code 1989# (why yes that IS a T.Swift reference) into the keypad and the door will unlock.
4. Front Entrance: the Granville street entrance is not yet set up for self-entry. So if you arrive via the front door please call or text your to come let you in. Feel free to hold the door open for the next student if you exit as they enter!
5. Wifi is available for parents while waiting! Check out our notice board (cork board at the top of the stairs) for name and password.
